The **Instrument Coach** is tasked with delivering small group and individual instrument tuition to students and supporting the whole school instrumental program.

- Maintain good communication with the Music leaders for Primary and Secondary and attend required meetings
- Contribute to the effective partnership with parents, the local community, other schools and outside agencies to support and improve pupils' achievement
- Work and contribute to the stated aims of the Music Department
- Ensure school musical instruments and inventory used by their students are in good working order
- Be responsible for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people
- Support the Vision, Mission, and Values of the School
